

TENDER NOTICE AND INVITATION TO TENDER

PRESSURE MANAGEMENT PHASE 1: PRIORITIZED PRV'S

Johannesburg Water hereby invites tenders from interested parties for the abovementioned Pressure Management programme on a water district basis which covers the Suburbs Oaklands, Norwood, Highlands North, Ochards, Glenhazel, Waverley, Fairmount Avenue, Bramley, Gresswold, Parkhurst, Parkview, Dunkeld West, Parkwood, Houghton and Orange Grove.

Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading designation of 7CE or higher who satisfy the criteria stated in the tender data may submit tender offers.

The project entails the construction of new and upgrading of existing PRV chambers, installation of approximately 3150m of 110mm, 160mm, 200mm, 250mm, & 315mm diameter high Impact uPVC Class 16 pipes by means of open trench excavation, installation of valves and associated fittings. All pipes will be installed using open trench excavation method excluding medium to high traffic carriage way crossings.
