

SCOPE: APPOINTMENT OF AN INDEPENDENT EXTERNAL Occupational Hygiene Service provider to Monitor/measure the indoor dust fall-out and PM10 and determination of their occupational exposure limit using a suitable test equipment as permitted by OHSA of 1993 and its regulations at the JW Ffennel Depot.

JW seeks to appoint an occupational hygiene service provider with experience in monitoring/measurement of hazardous gases and determining their occupational exposure limits. The specification include the following:

1. Monitoring/measurement of dust fall-out and PM10 in five (5) buildings.
2. Determine the occupational exposure limit (OEL) in five (5) buildings using a suitable test equipment as permitted by OHSA of 1993 and its regulations.
3. A report with recommendations based on the results.

The lead Occupational Hygienist must be registered with the Southern Africa Institute of Occupational Hygiene (SAIOH) and must at least have 3 years' experience in conducting the OEL for hazardous gases or related work. Service providers must submit the CVs of lead Occupational Hygienists and the proof of registration with SAIOH.

In addition to the quotation, the services providers must submit a brief description of how the above scope will be carried out and the type of testing equipment to be used. Service providers must submit valid calibration certificates of testing equipment to be used.

Please note that transportation fees must be included in the overall quotation.
