JW Update: 24 April 2022

City urges residents to reduce water consumption as power trip reoccurs at Rand Water's Vereeniging works

Eikenhof pump station was affected by the power trip, which occurred late yesterday afternoon at Rand Water's Vereeniging purification works. As a result previous gains made on improved levels at Johannesburg Water's systems were lost.

The impact thereof has been reduced supply to the following systems at Johannesburg Water:

- * Commando system (Crosby, Brixton and Hursthill Reservoirs)
- * Eagle Nest reservoir

These systems are severely constrained at this time. We request the assistance of customers to reduce consumption for essential purposes. Johannesburg Water continues to monitor the infrastructure impacted and will provide updates on supply to customers.

Customers in higher lying areas continue to experience low pressure/ no water during this period.
