Monitoring of JW Infrastructure impacted by reduced Rand Water supply

The following Johannesburg Water systems are impacted due to challenges at Rand Water Lethabo raw water system, which feeds Vereeniging works. The lowered supply at Eikenhof pump station has subsequently affected the Commando system.

*Commando Meter (Hurst hill Reservoir, Crosby Reservoir and Brixton Tower and Reservoir)

Hursthill reservoir continue to be at critically low levels, while Brixton and Crosby systems are stable. Customers in the higher lying areas, may experience no water/inconsistent supply.

Customers should report leaks and bursts in the area which may impact on the recovery of the system.
