Update on a burst pipe in Maroeladal

Johannesburg Water has appointed the contractor that will repair the pipe at the corner of First and Runnymead Roads. The repair work will resume on Friday, 16 February. At this stage, there is no estimated time of completion. The affected areas include Msawawa Informal Settlement, Chartwell, Kya Sands, Tirong Estate and surrounding areas. Water tankers have been dispatched to the affected areas. Further updates will be provided to customers.

Update on repairs in Jabulani and Protea Glen

Both the emergency repairs were completed on Wednesday night. However, the systems are still air-locked, resulting in slow recovery. Four roaming tankers have been dispatched to Protea Glen extensions and one to Jabulani. Further updates will be provided to customers.

Water issues in Craigavon and Cedar Lakes

Johannesburg Water is aware of low pressure to no water issues, every day. The depot is currently investigating the cause of these issues. In the meantime, water tankers have been arranged for the affected areas.
