Areas affected: Sunninghill, Gallo Manor, Edenburg, Wendywood, Waterfall, Woodmead, and parts of Morningside.

Street names: All streets.

Date: 19 March 2024

Time: 07:00 – 21:00

Impact on customers: No water

Reason for interruption: Structural assessment and Inspection on the reservoir and cleaning.

Alternative water supply: Water tankers will be provided to high-lying areas, as and when necessary.

REGION E

Areas affected: Alexandra, Wyneburg, Kew, Bramley, and parts of Glenhazel

Street names: All streets.

Date: 20 March 2024

Time: 07:00 – 21:00

Impact on customers: No water

Reason for interruption: Tie-in of new 110mm pipe to existing 160mm mainline, 200mm and 250mm.

Alternative water supply: Further details to be provided.

REGION D

Meadowlands and Aeroton reservoirs

Some areas that are supplied by the Meadowlands reservoir are experiencing low pressure to no water as the reservoir is currently supplying at 50% capacity. Some parts of the supply zone may also experience low pressure.

Affected areas include:

- Dube
- Orlando West
- Meadowlands
- Mofolo North and Central

Please note that other areas supplied by the Meadowlands reservoir may also be affected.

The Aeroton reservoir is also restricted which is affecting the water supply in Diepkloof Extension.
