Hector Norris pump station update

The Hector Norris pump station is currently experiencing technical challenges. Johannesburg Water's technical team and service provider are working on repairing the issue.

A bypass will be opened to supply CBD and Surrounding suburbs. However, poor pressure to no water is expected in high-lying areas of the supply zone.

Affected areas: Johannesburg CBD, Newtown, Selby, Braamfontein, and parts of Parktown.

There is currently no estimated time for completion. Further details will be provided once they become available.

Update: Central region repairs

The team is busy with excavations, and welding will commence thereafter.

Affected areas: Linden reservoir supply zone, Kensington B reservoir supply zone, Malanshof, President Park, Cresta, Darrenwood, Windsor, Windsor Glen, Robindale, Robinhills, Robin Acres, Randpark, Jacanlee, and Linden.

Further updates will be provided.

Meadowlands and Aeroton reservoirs

Some areas that are supplied by the Meadowlands reservoir are experiencing low pressure to no water as the reservoir is currently supplying at 50% capacity. Some parts of the supply zone may also experience low pressure.

Affected areas include:

- Dube
- Orlando West
- Meadowlands
- Mofolo North and Central

Please note that other areas supplied by the Meadowlands reservoir may also be affected.

The Aeroton reservoir is also restricted which is affecting the water supply in Diepkloof Extension.

Further details on progress will be provided to customers as it becomes available.

Date: 27 March 2024

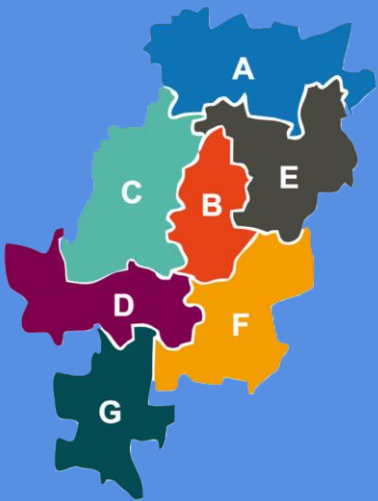
Time: 08:00 – 19:00
