Systems updates

Sandton System

- **Bryanston reservoir** remains low but supplying normal while tower has improved, and it is supplying normal. Poor pressure may be expected in the certain parts of high-lying areas of the tower zone.
- **Illovo reservoir** remains low while the tower remains critically low, pumping has resumed at half capacity. Improvement is expected overnight. Poor pressure may be expected in tower zone.
- **Linbro Park and Morningside reservoirs** slightly improved but remains low. Poor pressure is expected in the supply zones.
- **Marlboro reservoirs** are critically low due to high demand. Poor pressure may be expected in the supply zone, while the direct feeds are supplying fairly. (Linbro and Marlboro direct feeds).

Central Region

- **Berea and Alexandra Park reservoirs** remains critically low due to high demand. Poor pressure to no water is expected in the supply zones.

Deep South

- **Orange Farm and Lawley reservoirs** critically low to empty due to high demand. Poor pressure to no water is expected in the supply zones.
- **Lenasia Hospital Hill, Lenasia High Level and Ennerdale reservoirs** remains critically low, but supplying fairly. Poor pressure to be expected in the supply zones.

As part of the interventions, critically low reservoirs will be throttled overnight to build capacity.
