Systems update

Sandton System

- Bryanston reservoir supplying normally through the day however tower is low.
- Illovo reservoir and tower supplying normally through the day.
- Linbro Park and Morningside reservoirs supplying normally through the
- Marlboro reservoirs capacity levels remain normal through the day, poor pressure is expected due to high demand. The system is supplying fairly, including the direct feeds (Linbro and Marlboro direct feeds).

Central Region

Berea and Alexandra Park reservoirs – the capacity levels remain low due to high demand. Poor pressure is expected in certain parts of the supply zone.

Deep South Region

- Orange Farm levels are low and low pressure can be expected. Ennerdale and Lawley reservoirs – maintained normally through the day but remain low due to high demand. Poor pressure can be expected in the supply zone.
- Lenasia Hospital Hill and Lenasia High Level reservoirs the levels remain normal through the day and is supplying fairly. However, the supply levels remain low due to high demand in the system.

Johannesburg Water continues to monitor the affected systems frequently to gauge the progress of the system.
