## **Update on Johannesburg Water systems affected by Rand Water's Eikenhof pump station**

Impacted systems continue making notable progress as they recover. While some systems have made full recovery, some are still not at stable levels and those are being closely monitored. The bulk supplier continues to pump the additional 100ML, which contributes to improvements in the Roodepoort system.
