Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst).

Unplanned Interruptions

1. Emergency shutdown: Investigation of low flow at Honeydew reservoir

Johannesburg Water wishes to inform residents in the Honeydew reservoir zone of the emergency shutdown commencing at 10:00 on 20 January 2023. The specialist electromechanical team will isolate the inlet of the reservoir and inspect the relevant valves to identify the cause of low flow into the system.

Honeydew reservoir is currently at critically low levels. During the outage, customers in the reservoir zone will experience no water/ poor pressure.

Zandspruit, Cosmo City, Sonnedal, Northriding, Hoogland, Sundowner, Northgate, Honeypark, Randparkrif, Boundary Park, Laserpark, Bromhof, Olivedale, Boskruin, Sharonlea, Kyasands, Noordhang, Kelland, Honeydew Manor, Golden Harvest and Honeydew

The estimated completion time is 20:00 this evening.
