Daily water supply system status updates: Friday, 4 August 2023 (Afternoon)

Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst).

Unplanned interruption

1. Major burst on a 150mm pipe in Greenside

Johannesburg Water's operations team is attending to a major burst pipe at corner Sabie Road and Barry Hertzog Avenue in Greenside, Randburg. This will affect water supply in Greenside and Emmarentia. Customers may be affected by low pressure to no water. There is currently no estimated time of completion. Further updates will be provided to residents.

2. Orange Farm update

Repairs are ongoing and there is currently no estimated time for completion. Johannesburg Water teams are working around the clock to resolve the issue. The entity continues to provide alternative water supply for residents through roaming and stationary tankers.

3. City Power outage impacts Johannesburg Water's Witpoortjie pump station and tower

Johannesburg Water's Witpoortije pump station and tower have been affected by load shedding and a subsequent City Power outage on Friday, 4 August. This has affected pumping as the area is now experiencing power failure. Johannesburg Water's operations team is engaging City Power on the matter.

The Witpoortjie tower zone is currently empty. This has resulted in no water in parts of Witpoortiie, Groblerspark and parts of Princess. There is no estimated time of recovery at this stage. Further updates will be provided to customers.

Johannesburg Water has arranged alternative water supply through roaming trucks and stationary tanks:

- 3. Hoërskool Die Adelaar
- 4. Pick n Pay Shopping Centre
- 5. Witpoortjie Recreation Centre (near the tower)

4. Rand Water emergency repairs on the B1 pipeline

There are Rand Water emergency repairs on the B1 pipeline, which supplies water to Zwartkopjes Booster station. Repairs are underway and expected to be completed on 5 August 2023 at 01:00. Johannesburg Water is monitoring impacted systems as supply from Rand Water has been reduced.

Planned interruptions

1. **Areas affected:** Lenasia, Lenasia South, Anchorville, Lehae, Zakariyya Park, Vlakfontein, Finetown, Ennerdale South and extensions.

Street names: All streets
Date: 7 August 2023
Time: 06:00 – 18:00

Impact on customers: No water

Reason for interruption: Maintenance work required on the bulk pipeline to ensure improved

water supply

Location of water tankers: Water tankers will be provided if the shutdown exceeds 24 hours

2. Rand Water planned maintenance on 9 August to impact Soweto

There is a planned Rand Water shutdown that will take place for 17 hours from 07:00 to midnight on Wednesday, 9 August 2023. The shutdown will impact various areas around Soweto. The purpose of the planned maintenance is for Rand Water to repair leaking bypass pipelines, as well as valves on the F33, F40 and F44.

Supply to the Chiawelo and Doornkop West reservoirs will be affected, as well as the direct feeds to the Tshepisong and Chiawelo regions. As a result, customers in these reservoir zones and direct feed supply areas will be affected by low pressure to no water.

Customers are encouraged to store sufficient water, at least two days before the outage (Monday, 7 August). Johannesburg Water also urges customers to use water sparingly during the shutdown.

Direct feed areas include:

- All Tshepisong (phases one to seven)
- All Ebumnandini Informal Settlement
- All Slovoville Village
- All Slovoville Informal Settlement
- All Slovoville compound
- Leratong Village

Recovery may take up to 48 hours after the completion of the maintenance work. Alternative water supply will be arranged, and the location of the water tankers will be communicated in due course. Further updates will be provided to customers.
