Daily water supply system status updates: Monday, 19 June 2023 (Afternoon)

Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst).

Unplanned interruptions

1. Cosmos Reservoir

Please note that we will be cleaning Cosmos Reservoir from Monday, 12 June 2023. The estimated time of completion of the cleaning process including water testing will take approximately 7 days. During the cleaning process the reservoir will be shut, and drained. However, we will be supplying the affected areas through a bypass line. Cosmos Reservoir supplies Lenasia and Thembalihle areas.

2. No water and poor pressure in Berea reservoir zone

Currently, the Berea reservoir is critically low to empty. Water supply is being diverted to the Berea reservoir, while network teams are flushing the network to remove air from the system. Johannesburg Water is monitoring water levels. It may take some time for complete recovery. Customers in the reservoir zone may still experience no water and/or poor pressure.

Alternative water supply through mobile tankers will be provided in the following areas: Bertrams, Bezuidenhout Valley, Malvern, Cyrildene, Bruma and De Wetshof.

6. Rand Water postpones planned shutdown

Johannesburg Water would like to advise residents that Rand Water planned shutdown impacting the Eikenhof Pump Station from 20 to 22 June 2023 has been postponed until further notice. The purpose of the planned shutdown is to complete a tie-in between the A19 and B14 with a new pipeline, installation of isolation valves, and systems upgrades at Rand Water's Eikenhof pump station.

Further updates on the new dates and times will be provided to residents.

8. Rand Water planned maintenance at Daleside pump station to impact Ennerdale

There will be a planned Rand Water shutdown on Friday, 30 June 2023 from 09:00 to 17:00. The bulk water supplier will be conducting maintenance at Daleside pump station. It is estimated that optimal recovery of the systems may take approximately five days.

Affected areas include

Orange Farm High Level Reservoir: Drieziek, Lakeside, Orange Farm and Stretford. Ennerdale/ Lawley Reservoir: Ennerdale South, Ennerdale Exts, Finetown, Grasmere, Mid-Ennerdale, Lawley Exts and Lawley Estate.

Customers in the affected areas may experience low pressure to no water during the period. Alternative water supply will be arranged for critical customers such as clinics and hospitals. Further updates will be provided.
