



Daily water supply system status updates: Thursday, 27 July 2023 (Afternoon)

Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst).

Unplanned interruptions

1. Areas affected: Diepkloof, including all extensions and zones

Street names: All streets

Start date & time: 26 July 2023 at 07:00

End date & time: 27 July 2023 at 22:00

Impact on customers: No water

Reason for interruption: Repairing a water leak on a 400 mm diameter AC pipeline

Location of water tankers: Water tankers will be provided if the planned work exceeds the stipulated time

2. Ennerdale reservoir update

Following the isolation of the Orange Farm Reservoir on Wednesday (26 July), an unexpected overflow occurred, which prompted Johannesburg Water to request Rand Water to reduce their supply to the reservoir. This led to water supply challenges to the Ennerdale and Lawley reservoirs. Consequently, the water outage now also affects the Ennerdale, Mid-Ennerdale, Lawley, and Poortjie areas. Orange Farm, including all the extensions, Drieziek, Lakeside, and Stretford, which are supplied by the Orange Farm reservoir, are also still affected.

Technical teams from Johannesburg Water and Rand Water are diverting the water supply towards the Ennerdale reservoir while the entity sources material to repair the damaged pipe at the outlet of the Orange Farm reservoir.

Roaming water tankers are being supplied by the entity and residents can contact their ward councillors for the locations of the tankers. There is no estimated time of completion for the repairs at this moment. Further updates will be provided.

3. Kaalfontein outage update

Kaalfontein and Allandale residents still have no water supply due to a burst pipe that occurred last week. Although the burst water pipe has since been repaired, Johannesburg Water is now fixing an adjacent sewer pipe that was impacted. The water in the network is still isolated (closed) at this stage and is currently being tested to ensure it was not contaminated during the repairs. Once the test results are released and the water is deemed safe for consumption, supply will be opened up again.
