Daily water supply system status updates: Thursday, 31 August 2023 (Afternoon)

Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst).

Unplanned interruption

Johannesburg Water systems update

The following Johannesburg Water reservoirs and towers are still struggling with capacity due to poor supply and high-water demand.

South Hills tower

Critically low due to poor supply. Low pressure to no water exempted in supply zone.

Commando System

- Crosby reservoir: Remains low but supplying normally as it has improved
- Hursthill 1 reservoir: Critically low due to high demand and slow recovery. Network has been reconfigured to augment Hursthill 1 reservoir supply. Low pressure to no water is expected in high-lying areas.
- Hursthill 2 reservoir: Critically low due to high demand and slow recovery. Supplying normally, but low pressure is expected in high-lying areas.
- Brixton reservoir: Remains low but supplying normally. Outlet will be throttled at 50% to build capacity this evening, at 22:00 and opened at 04:00 in the morning.
- Brixton tower: Recovered and operating normally.

Eagles Nest reservoir

Remains critically low due to poor supply and high demand. Customers in this supply zone should expect low water pressure.

Doornkop reservoir

Remains low, but stable as supply has improved overnight. It is supplying normally.

Linden 1 tower

Empty due to low supply. No water is expected on the supply zone. Recovery is expected overnight.

Alternative water supply is still being provided through 14 roaming trucks deployed at various key points of the struggling areas. Johannesburg Water is monitoring the systems and will provide more information.
