# Daily water supply system status updates: Tuesday, 29 August 2023 (Afternoon)

Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst).

## **Unplanned interruption**

1. Area(s) affected: Diepkloof zone 6

Street name(s): All streets **Date: 29 August 2023 Time:** 07:00 – 22:00

Impact on customers: No water

Reason for interruption: Repairing a burst water pipe which feeds Orlando East reservoir Location of water tankers: Water tankers will be provided if the planned work exceeds the

stipulated time

# 2. Update on Johannesburg Water systems

The following Johannesburg Water reservoirs and towers are still struggling with capacity due to poor supply and high water demand.

### Linden 1 reservoir and tower

The reservoir is operating normally while the tower is critically low due to high consumption. Recovery is expected overnight.

#### **South Hills tower**

Critically low due to poor supply and high consumption. Low pressure is expected in the supply zone.

## **Commando System**

- **Crosby reservoir:** Has improved slightly since the morning and operating normally.
- Hursthill 1 and 2 reservoirs: Critically low due to high demand and slow recovery. Low pressure to no water is expected in higher lying areas.
- Brixton reservoir and tower: The reservoir remains critically low and the outlet is 50% open. Low pressure is expected in the supply zone. The Brixton tower is critically low, but slowly recovering. Pumping is still at half the capacity due to the low levels at the Brixton reservoir. Recovery of the tower is expected overnight.

### **Eagles Nest reservoir**

Remains critically low due to poor supply and high demand. Customers in this supply zone should expect low water pressure.

#### Doornkop reservoir

The reservoir is critically low, and recovery is slow due to high demand. Low pressure expected and customers are requested to reduce consumption to allow recovery.
