UNPLANNED MAINTENANCE

Burst pipe: Linden Reservoir 1

There is a burst pipe on a 500mm steel pipeline at the corner of Pretoria Avenue and Dover Street.

Currently, the Johannesburg Water team is draining the pipeline so that assessments can be made. After assessments are completed and the material needed is determined, repairs will begin.

Residents in the supply zone will be affected by poor pressure to no water.

3. Ferndale
4. Moret
5. Randburg
6. Part of Bryanston

There is no estimated time for completion.
