# **UNPLANNED MAINTENANCE**

**Update on Randjieslaagte Reservoir** 

Repairs were completed yesterday morning, and the reservoir is recovering. The reservoir level remains low but improving, the outlet is fully open and supplying normally. The reservoir level will gradually improve, and more recovery is expected overnight.

Most areas in the supply zone have water, Johannesburg Water is monitoring and attending to airlocks and no water as and when required. Further updates will be provided in due course.

#### **Orange Farm Reservoir update**

Johannesburg Water is expecting the necessary material to be delivered tomorrow, 23 May 2024. Upon arrival of the material, the repairs will then commence. A valve has been installed to isolate the damaged part of the pipe, allowing water restoration in some parts of Orange Farm.

#### However, the following areas are still affected:

- 1. Orange Farm Ext.1, Ext.6A, Ext.6B, and Ext. 7B.
- 2. Stretford Ext.3 and Ext.4
- 3. Lakeside Ext.4.

Johannesburg Water will continue to provide alternative water supply through water tankers. Further updates will be provided.
