Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst). Tuesday, 21 May 2024 (Afternoon)

UNPLANNED MAINTENANCES

Bryanston Pump Station and Tower

There is a pipe burst on the pumping main to the Bryanston Tower. As a result, pumping has been stopped so that the Johannesburg Water team can conduct assessments on the type of repairs and interventions required.

Consequently, water will be isolated (closed) and customers within the supply zone of the pump station and tower will be affected by poor pressure to no water until the work is completed.

The estimated completion time is 20:00 tonight, and if repairs have been completed successfully, it will take several hours for the water to fill the network and for customers to have normal water supply.

Update on Randjieslaagte Reservoir

A Johannesburg Water team is currently on site conducting repair work. The inlet has been isolated (closed), and the team is pumping the chamber. Welding work will commence once the line is completely isolated. The team will be replacing a section of the inlet pipe.

The estimated time for completion is 20:00 tonight. Further details will be provided.

Update: Lonehill and Beverly

Johannesburg Water is aware of the water supply issues in Lonehill and Beverly.

This is the result of a burst water pipe at corner Uranium and Winnie Mandela Drive in Fourways. Although the pipe was repaired on Friday and water restored to the other affected areas, water has still not been returned in Lonehill and Beverly.

To address the issue, technical teams will open water at Dennis Road; however, please note that this will result in a water leak along Lonehill Boulevard by the river next to the fire department.

Opening the valve may help relieve the poor pressure and restore water supply gradually throughout the day. There is currently no estimated time for restoration. Johannesburg Water is monitoring the situation.
