The repairs to the Randburg Reservoir that were scheduled to be conducted on Monday, 10 June 2024, has been postponed to Wednesday, 12 June 2024.

The supply to reservoir will be isolated(closed) to allow for repairs, and this will affect some systems.

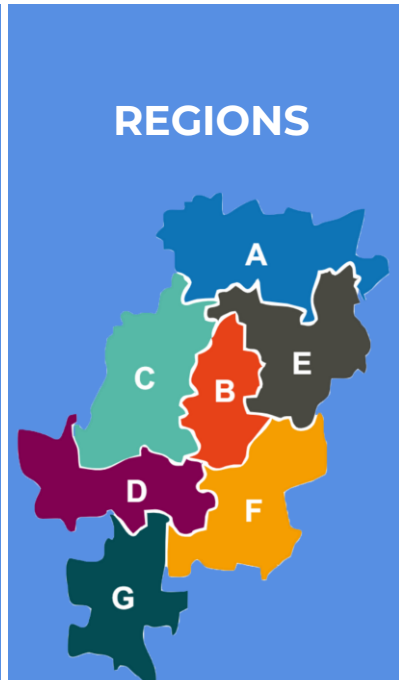
