

DAILY WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM STATUS UPDATES

Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst). **Tuesday 9 July 2024 (Morning)**

PLANNED MAINTENANCES

Suburbs affected: Ferndale

Streets affected: Corner West and Rocky Street, Rommer Street, Strike Street, Hylauma Street

Date: 9 July 2024

Time: 08:00 – 16:00

Impact on customers: No water for the duration of the 8 hours

Reason for interruption: Tie-in 150mm new pipeline to 110mm existing mainline.

Benefit to customers: Improved service delivery and continuity of water supply

Suburbs affected: Lenasia, Lenasia Ext. 1 and 2

Streets affected: Gemsbok Street, Kingfisher Street, Hummingbird Avenue, Cuckoo Avenue, Smew Avenue, and Guinea Fowl Street

Reservoirs/ Water Towers Affected: None/Direct Feed

Date: 11 July 2024

Time: 08:30 – 23:00

Impact on customers: No water on above mentioned streets and poor water pressure on adjacent streets for a duration of 15 hours.

Reason for interruption: Tie-in of the newly constructed 200mm water pipe and decommissioning of the old pipe along Gemsbok and Guineafowl Street (Phase 1 of 2)

Benefit to customers: Improved service delivery and continuity of water supply

Suburbs affected: Poortjie Township and Dark City Informal Settlement

Streets affected: All streets

Date: 12 July 2024

Time: 09:00 – 16:00

Impact on customers: No water for the duration of 7 hours

Reason for interruption: Relocation of a water pipe due to road construction.

Alternative water: Further details to be provided

Benefit to customers: Improved service delivery and continuity of water supply

Suburbs affected Lenasia, Lenasia Ext. 1 and 2

Streets affected: Gemsbok Str, Kingfisher Str, Hummingbird Ave, Cuckoo Ave. Smew Ave and Guineafowl Robin Ave, Rose Ave, Anemone Ave and Camella Ave.

Date: 17 July 2024

Time: 08:00 – 23:00

Impact on customers: No water on above mentioned streets and poor water pressure on adjacent streets for a duration of 14 hours.

Reason for interruption: Tie-in of the newly constructed 200mm water pipe and decommissioning of the old pipe along Gemsbok and Guineafowl Street (Phase 2 of 2) .

Alternative water: Further details to be provided

Benefit to customers: Improved service delivery and continuity of water supply
