UNPLANNED MAINTENANCES

Burst pipe in Ferndale

Water has been isolated (closed) to allow for repairs to be conducted on a 350mm steel pipe burst at corner Republic Road and Malibongwe Drive in Ferndale. As a result, residents will experience poor pressure to no water

Affected areas: Ferndale, Strijdompark, Kensington B, Randburg, parts of Bryanston, Moret, parts of Blairgowrie, and Bordeaux.

The completion time can only be estimated once excavations are completed, and the necessary material is determined.

Alternative water supply will be prioritised for hospitals, clinics, schools, and police stations. If the repairs have not been completed in 24 hours, then roaming tankers will be allocated to affected areas.

REPAIRS COMPLETED

Repairs have been completed and water is expected to be restored around 17:00. Some areas should start having water from this evening and some in the early hours of Saturday.
