## UNPLANNED MAINTENANCES

### Discovery and Horizon update

Johannesburg Water is aware of the water supply disruptions in some parts of Roodepoort.

A Rand Water team is changing a bulk meter in Discovery. As a result, customers are experiencing poor pressure to no water in some parts. The areas affected are Discovery, Horizon, Ontdekkers Park, and surrounding areas.

There is currently no estimated time for completion. Further details will be provided as and when it becomes available. Stationary tankers are being arranged and the locations will be communicated with the relevant ward councillors.

## PLANNED MAINTENANCES

### Suburbs affected: Lenasia, Lenasia Ext. 1 and 2

**Streets affected:** Gemsbok Street, Kingfisher Street, Hummingbird Avenue, Cuckoo Avenue, Smew Avenue, Guinea Fowl Street, Robin Avenue, Rose Avenue, Anemone Avenue, and Camella Avenue.

**Impact on customers:** No water on above mentioned streets and poor water pressure on adjacent streets for a duration of 14 hours.

**Reason for interruption:** Tie-in of the newly constructed 200mm water pipe and decommissioning of the old pipe along Gemsbok and Guineafowl Street (Phase 2 of 2).
