Time: 08:00 – 16:00

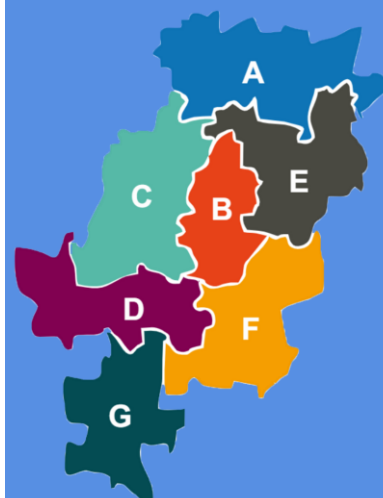
