PLANNED MAINTENANCES

REGION D

Suburbs affected: Meadowlands zones 1-12, part of Orlando West, Dube, Mofolo North and Central, Tshepo Themba Hospital, Meadowlands hostel and Dube Hostel

Streets affected: All streets within the suburbs

Start date and time: 12 November 2024 at 08:00

End date and time: 14 November 2024 at 08:00

Impact on customers: No Water for duration of 48 hours

Reason for interruption: Retrofitting the main PRV chamber that is supplying Meadowlands reservoir, the Tower and the direct feed to the Meadowlands area.

Alternative water supply: Water tankers to be provided

Benefit to customers: Improved service delivery and continuity of water supply

REGION C

Suburbs affected: Constantia Kloof, Florida Park, and Florida Hills

Streets affected: All streets

Start date and time: 18 November 2024 at 09:00

End date and time: 21 November 2024 at 20:00

Impact on customers: Johannesburg Water will continue to pump directly to the customer; however, this would be subject to continued power supply for the duration of the maintenance

Reason for interruption: Tower maintenance
