Water supply status update by exception (i.e., areas affected due to supply constraint and not service interruption from occasional pipe burst). **Monday, 25 November 2024 (Afternoon)**

UNPLANNED MAINTENANCE

REGION E

COMPLETED: Burst pipe in Houghton

The repairs have been completed, and a team has been dispatched to open the valves to charge the system. It will take several hours for the water supply to return to normal.

Suburbs affected: Houghton, Orange Grove, Abbotsford, Lyndhurst, Killarney, Saxonwold, Parkwood, Rosebank, Melrose, Norwood, Dunkeld, Parktown North, Birdhaven, Atholl, Oaklands, Parkhurst, Westcliff, Parkview, and Forest Town

Time: There is currently no estimated time for completion

Impact on customers: Low pressure to no water

Reason for interruption: Burst 750 mm water pipe at 1 Second Avenue and West Street at Houghton Estate. Parktown 1 and 2 Reservoirs are currently isolated (closed).

Reason for interruption: To lower and relocate the existing 75mm pipelines

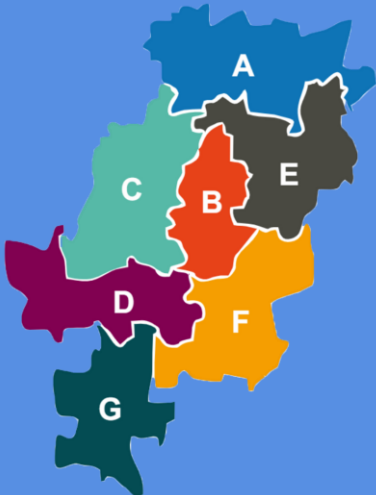
Alternative water supply: To be provided if the shutdown exceeds 24 hours
