

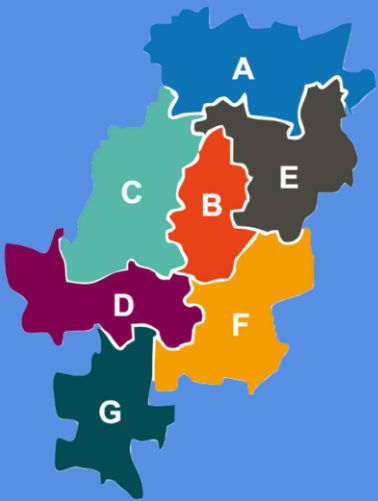
DAILY WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM STATUS UPDATES

REGION E	<p>Burst pipe: Glenhazel</p> <p>Water has been isolated (closed) to conduct repairs on to a burst pipe in Northfield Avenue, Glenhazel.</p> <p>Affected areas: Bramley, Bramley View, parts of Alexandra, Lombardy East and West, parts of Lyndhurst, River Park, Kew, Rembrandt Park, Fairmount, Sandringham, Sydenham, Savoy Estate, Sunningdale, and Bramley Gardens</p> <p>The estimated time of completion is 24:00 tonight.</p>

water supply restored. Overall, the system is in recovery as it builds capacity, more areas will receive water supply. Roaming water tankers have been deployed to provide relief to impacted areas.

Areas affected: Kliptown, Nancefield, Eldorado Park, Klipspruit West, Klipspruit, Pimville, Rivasdale, and surrounding areas.

Suburbs affected: Alexander Park Reservoir

Streets affected: All streets

Start date and time: 10 December 2024 at 10:00

End date and time: 12 December 2024 at 10:00

Impact on customers: Bypass to be utilised during the maintenance, providing limited water for duration of two days.

Reason for interruption: Drop Test (Leak Test)

Alternative water supply: To be provided if the maintenance exceeds 24 hours

Benefit to customers: Improved service delivery, reduction of water losses, and continuity of water supply

Suburbs affected: Protea Glen extensions 1, 2, 3 and 4, Protea City, Doornkop, Green Village, and Dobsonville Gardens

UPDATE: As of last night, Extension 1 and 2 are reported to have seen some improvements, though with little water pressure in some areas. Technical teams continue with interventions aimed at boosting water supply, to provide relief for customers.

Roaming water trucks continue to be deployed to supply the areas that are still affected.

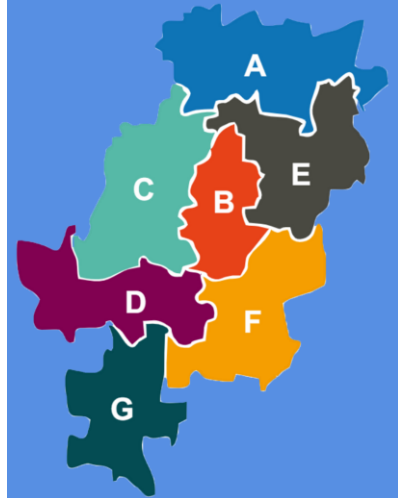
