UNPLANNED MAINTENANCES

COMPLETED

Burst pipe: Moroka

The repairs to the major burst pipe along Vundla Drive, Moroka have been completed and water has been opened.

Johannesburg Water will, however, continue providing alternative water supply until water is fully restored. The teams will monitor the situation until full recovery.

Affected areas: Moroka, Central West Jabavu, White City, Moroka North, and Dube Village.

Suburbs affected: Bellairspark, Boskruin, Boundary Park, Bromhof, Bushill Estate, Cosmo City, Honey Park, Honeydew Manor, Hoogland, Huntershill, Kevin Ridge, Kya Sands, Laser Park, Noordhang, Northriding, Northgate, Northwold, Olivedale, Randparkrif, Sharonlea, Radiokop, Sonnedal, Honeydew Ridge, Sundowner, Tres Jolie, Zandspruit, Harveston, Mogale City, and Kim Bult.

Streets affected: All streets

Start date and time: 9 January 2025 at 09:00

End date and time: 9 January 2025 at 21:00

Reason for interruption: Removal of cracked level control valve from the inlet of the Honeydew Reservoir.

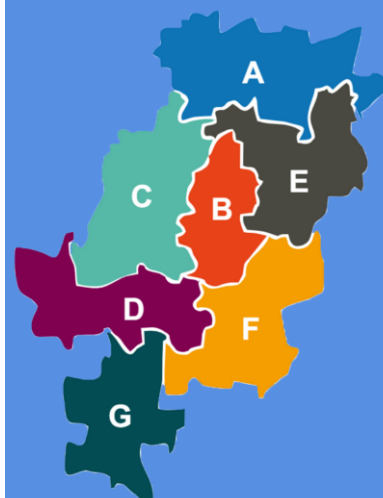
Impact on customers: The network will be supplied by the reservoir until the stored capacity runs out.
